

To keep the underlying technology in RadBlue tools up-to-date, we periodically change the Java required by our tools. These updates should have a minimal impact on your environment.

Each installer automatically checks to see if the required Java version is available on the PC on which the tool is being installed. If it isn't the installer will automatically download and install a local copy that the RadBlue tools will use going forward. This installation is done in a manner that will not affect the version of Java that is running on your computer for general use by other programs.

NOTE: Starting with Release 48, the appropriate Java version is now included with the RadBlue installer.
