Configuring RST for Windows 2007

If you are installing a version of the RadBlue System Tester (RST) released *prior* to version 9 (April 7, 2010) on a Windows 2007 operating system, you may need to perform additional configuration after completing the standard installation.

This additional installation step is not required for RST 9 or later.

Procedure

To install an application on Windows 2007, you must have permission to write to the **perf** directory. To make this change, you must run the **rst-permission.bat** file.

1. Open a command prompt as an administrator.
 - a. Go to: **Start Panel > Accessories**
 - b. Right-click **Command Prompt**
 - c. Select **Run as administrator**.
2. Change directories to RST's **bin** directory by typing:
cd \[install directory]\radblue\gsa\script\bin
For example, if you used the default RST installation directory, you would type:
cd \program files\Radblue System Tester\radblue\gsa\script\bin
3. Type **rst-permissions.bat** and press **Enter** to run the batch file.
